Course Information Floristry - Advanced

This is a course, which will include making a variety of different styles of floral arrangements. Designs will include bridal and funeral work, presentation and gift designs, and gift-wrapping. Designs will be made using mainly fresh but some artificial materials. Designs will be made using wire, moss and oasis. It should be noted that not all designs will be suitable for home decoration after the class. Writing up of notes, producing a folder of evidence and homework projects can be expected.
